Section 6-4.2. Persons involved in developing specifications; use of consultants; monthly reports required. — A. The persons involved in developing educational specifications for new or remodeled facilities of Suffolk Public Schools should include: (1) the School Board which adopts policies, approves the final specifications, employs the architect, and provides the budget; (2) the superintendent, who provides administrative leadership, interpretation, and evaluation; (3) principals and teachers; (4) other certified staff members; (5) student and citizen representatives; and (6) the architect. Any committee appointed by the school superintendent and responsible for developing educational specifications for new or remodeled facilities will also include a member of the School Board appointed by the School Board to offer input and/or suggestions to the committee.

- B. Consultants may be used in the development of educational specifications when deemed necessary by the superintendent and the School Board.
- C. During planning and construction of new or remodeled facilities, the superintendent will provide monthly reports to the School Board regarding the status of construction. (Adopted February 9, 1995)
