



English


SMART Goal: By June 2025, the SOL pass rate for the Students with Disabilities subgroups will increase by 10 percentage points, from 29% to 39%, through the implementation of targeted instructional strategies, individualized support plans, and ongoing progress monitoring to ensure sustained academic growth.

Evidence-based Intervention:

Visible Learning for Teachers: Maximizing Impact on Learning by John Hattie Flexible Grouping, Differentiated Instruction, Science of Reading, Phonemic Awareness and Phonics: <u>UFLI Strategy</u>

- Measure the scores on the VDOE growth assessment administered in the spring.
- Measure the scores on common formative assessments administered throughout the year.

Staff Measures:

- Track the percentage of teachers who systematically use student performance data to form and regularly adjust flexible groups, ensuring that instruction is effectively differentiated to meet students' evolving needs.
- Monitor the number of staff who participate in professional development sessions focused on targeted instructional strategies for improving cognitive skills.

Math

SMART Goal: By June 2025, the SOL pass rate for the Students with Disabilities subgroup will increase by 10 percentage points, from 53% to 63%, through the implementation of targeted instructional strategies, individualized support plans, and ongoing progress monitoring to ensure sustained academic growth.

Visible Learning for Teachers: Maximizing Impact on Learning by John Hattie

- Monitor and record the frequency and effectiveness of students' use of targeted interventions during instruction and assessments.
- Track the progress of students with disabilities by administering regular formative assessments.





Math (con't)

Staff Measures:

- Track the consistency and fidelity with which staff implement targeted interventions for students with disabilities.
- Monitor the number of staff who participate in professional development sessions focused on targeted instructional strategies for improving cognitive skills.

Science


SMART Goal: By June 2025, student performance in the Earth/Space Systems and Earth Resources reporting category will improve from a scaled score of 32/50 to 35/50. This will be achieved through the implementation of targeted instructional strategies focusing on the skills of predicting, inferencing, applying, comparing, analyzing, describing, and evaluating data-driven insights.

Evidence-based Intervention:

Use of evidence to critique claims and sense-making Writing Across the Curriculum

- Track student assessment data will be monitored through the use of CFA's and other formative and summative assessments
- Measure the level of student participation and engagement in using evidence to critique claims and sense making.





Science (con't)

Staff Measures:

- Track the percentage of science teachers who consistently integrate claim critiquing and sense-making in their lesson plans and classroom activities.
- Monitor the percentage of science teachers who complete professional development sessions focused on critiquing claims and sense-making.

Alignment to the Strategic Plan: GOAL 1: Students will develop characteristics of a Virginia graduate to include critical thinking, creative thinking, collaboration, communication, citizenship and growth in order to demonstrate academic excellence.

- Measure the level of student participation and engagement in using disciplinary literacy.






Social Studies (con't)

Staffing Supports

SMART Goal: By June 2025, we will retain at least 80% of our special education teachers by implementing support programs, professional development, and mentorship opportunities.

Evidence-based Intervention: <u>The Impact of Continuous Professional Development on Teacher Retention and Performance</u>

Student Measures:

- Track the percentage of students meeting their Individualized Education Program (IEP) goals.
- Survey special education students to monitor growth in teacher impact and relationships.

Staff Measures:

- Survey special education teachers to assess job knowledge and satisfaction, with a focus on support, relationships and professional development.
- Track the number of special education teachers engaged in mentorship programs, which can contribute to higher retention.

Professional Learning

SMART Goal: By June 2025, teachers will enhance their Tier 1 instructional practices to effectively support identified sub-groups (e.g., students with disabilities, English Language Learners, and Economically Disadvantaged students) by participating in at least four targeted professional learning sessions.


Evidence-based Intervention: Hattie Visible Learning: Hattie Research Explicit Instruction, Data Collection and Analysis, Flexible Grouping, Differentiated Instruction, Training and Support, Science of Reading

Student Measures:

- Track the progress of identified sub-groups (e.g., students with disabilities, English Language Learners, Economically Disadvantaged students) through bi-weekly formative assessments.
- Monitor student engagement and participation levels in classroom activities, particularly within the identified sub-groups.



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


Professional Learning (con't)

Staff Measures:


- Evaluate the extent to which teachers are applying differentiated instruction strategies in their classrooms, as observed during instructional rounds, peer observations, and through teacher self-reflections.
- Track teacher participation in the targeted professional learning sessions and assess how effectively they are implementing the strategies learned

School Climate Supports

SMART Goal: By June 2025, the gap of chronically absent students from the targeted neighborhoods vs non targeted neighborhoods will decrease 10% through the development and implementation of outreach and support programs.

Evidence-based Intervention: Attendance support program

- Analyze daily attendance for each student to identify patterns of absenteeism.
- Track student participation in the outreach and support strategies.





School Climate Supports (con't)

Staff Measures:

- Monitor attendance data to identify patterns and trends specific to the targeted areas.
- Implement small student support groups targeting the focus area of attendance.
